- Points Competition is a modified Stableford
 Competition. Handicaps are taken into consideration,
 and we hope this simplified scoring system will make
 more sense to you.
- Points rounds are scheduled June 7th, June 21st, July 19th & August 23rd.
- Prizes are awarded at the end of the season for the best three of four rounds.

Points Scoring Explained

- Play your regular game and in the row below your score, make note of the points you earn on each hole for birdies, pars and bogeys. The sum of these points added to your handicap will be your points total for the round.
- Handicaps will be capped at 34 to keep it equitable because even golfers with a high handicap can make pars and bogeys.
- If you play to your handicap, you will have approximately 36 points.

0 points	double bogey or higher (2 over par)	
1 point	bogey	(1 over par)
2 points	par	
3 points	birdie	(1 under par)
4 points	eagle	(2 under par)



- Jane has a 27 handicap. Her 14 points + 27 hcp = 41 points
- Sue has a 13 handicap. Her 19 points + 13hcp = **32 points**

 The best three of the four rounds will be used to determine the winners (the most points).

 Results will be posted on the website and in the locker room.
