- We have an opt in competition for putts and chip-ins.
 This competition is open to all ladies who play in the
 Wednesday or Saturday draw on the allocated days.
- The charge for season will be \$20 which amounts to a toonie a week for the 10 eligible playing days which include the Personal Best Score and Hidden Partners Competition days.
- There will be weekly payouts for the designated days which we will announce and track through the season with payment to all winners at the end of the year.

• Payment should be made prior to May 29 which is the date of our first Wednesday Ladies Morning Competition. (You are welcome to join after this date, but you will only be eligible for competition from that date onward). Instructions for signing up will be sent out in May. The \$20 will be deducted from your account. Members preferring to pay cash may do so through the office or pro shop (a charge and credit will be reflected on your monthly account).

 A form will be distributed to each group on the day of play. At the end of the round, please fill in each player's name and the number of putts and chip-ins.
 Submit this form along with your scorecards.



- The number of participants will determine the amount of the pot. Payouts will be made to first and second place for the lowest number of putts and to first and second place for the most chip-ins.
- Ties will split the winnings. If there is only one chipin recorded in a given week, the winner will take all. If no chip-ins are recorded, the amount will be carried over to the next week. A chip-in is a ball that is holed from off the green regardless of the club used. If any part of the ball is on the green, it is considered to be on the green and would not count as a chip-in.



- Results will be posted online and in the locker room.
- Prizes (Pro Shop Gift Certificates) will be awarded at the end of the season.
- Birdies on your "counting day"
 (Wednesday or Saturday) can be recorded in the Ladies Locker Room and a draw will be made at the end of the season to determine the winners.
